

**SELF-SUFFICIENCY SCALE CHART
TO USE WITH THE FAMILY PROFILE FORM**

With some of our clients, it is not appropriate to assess them in all 14 Domains of the Family Profile Form.

- If the client does not have children, Domains 12 (Child Care) and 14 (Child Education/Development) would not be used.
- If the client has a permanent disability, prohibiting him/her from being employed, Domain 10 (Employment/Employability) would not be used.

A scale is used to measure a client's movement toward self-sufficiency. If all 14 Domains are not used the range of scores for each level of self-sufficiency would vary. The following chart shows the range of scores when using 11-14 Domains on the Self-Sufficiency Scale.
