

Residential Program Definitions

COMMUNITY RESIDENTIAL REHABILITATION (CRR)

A CRR is a transitional residential program in the community for persons with a psychiatric diagnosis who are 18 years of age or older. These programs are licensed by the Office of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services (OMHSAS). CRR's are specifically designed and operated to assist persons with a psychiatric diagnosis to live as independently as possible through the provision of training and assistance in the skills of community living. This is considered a program and discharge planning will begin upon admission. Coordination with the Service Coordinator/CTT is required.

Full care CRR's provide living accommodations for persons with staff on site 24/7. The programs are in apartment buildings or small group home settings. The apartment settings require payment of 40% of income and the individual is responsible for maintaining his/her apartment, cooking, cleaning, shopping with assistance from staff as needed. The Group Home settings require 72% of income for Room and Board. Referrals must go through the Allegheny County OBH Residential Referral Process.

COMPREHENSIVE MENTAL HEALTH PERSONAL CARE HOME (CMHPCH)

A facility in which food shelter and personal assistance or supervision are provided for a period exceeding 24 hours for four (4) or more adults who are not relatives of the operator, who do not require the services in or of a licensed long term facility, but who do require assistance or supervision in matters such as dressing, bathing, diet, financial management, evacuation of residency in the event of an emergency or medication prescribed for self-administration.

The CMHPCH's are operated by contracted Mental Health Provider Agencies with funding from the Office of Behavioral Health. These CMHPCH's must follow the Comprehensive Mental Health Personal Care Home standards developed by OBH and meet the requirements of the Personal Care Home regulations (Chapter 2620). In the CMHPCH individuals have a private room, personal spending allowance of \$150.00 per month, a resident council, and daily on site activities and groups which are voluntary. Referrals must go through the Allegheny County OBH Residential Referral Process.

LONG TERM STRUCTURED RESIDENCE **(LTSR)**

An LTSR is a highly structured therapeutic residential mental health treatment facility designed to serve persons 18 years of age and older who do not need inpatient hospitalization but who require mental health treatment and supervision on an ongoing 24-hour per day basis. Admission is limited to individuals who require the services. Admission may occur voluntarily under section 201 of the act (50 P.S. 7210) or involuntarily under sections 304,305 or 306 of the act (P.S.). These facilities are locked facilities. These programs are licensed by the Office of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services (OMHSAS). Referrals must go through the Allegheny County OBH Residential Referral Process.

24/7 SUPPORTIVE HOUSING

This is the same concept as Supportive Housing except that the staff is located on site 24/7 to provide extra support to those individuals who need this level of care. These programs are usually located in an apartment building setting where the staff has an office as well. These beds are monitored by Allegheny County OBH and referrals to these programs must go through the Centralized Residential Referral Process. This is not a licensed program.

SPECIALIZED RESIDENCES

These facilities are designed to serve adults who require a structured setting and in some cases 1:1 staff supervision on a 24/7 basis. The focus of these facilities will be to provide intensive support for individuals who have very complex needs and will need a lot of supervision and support. Behavioral Assessments and plans are very common in these facilities and the program tries to provide a lot of structure. Close communication, coordination, and interaction with the Service Coordinator/CTT is required. These small 3 person homes are not licensed. Referrals must go through the Allegheny County OBH Residential Referral Process.

DOMICILIARY CARE SERVICES **(Dom Care)**

A Domiciliary Care Home is a home certified by the Area Agency on Aging for the purpose of providing a supervised living arrangement in a homelike setting for individuals who are unable to live independently. Persons eligible for placements would be individuals 18 years of age or older who need assistance with personal care and activities of daily living. The DHS/OBH contracts with Community Human Services for 6 Dom Care beds. Referrals to this program must go through the Allegheny County OBH Residential Referral process.


