- › Care for no more than three Dom Care residents in their home
- › Meet Provider Certification Requirements

- › Receive around-the-clock care
- › Feel the security of having another adult around
- › Are eligible for a financial supplement if on a limited income
- › Are offered introductory visits to the home
- › Receive ongoing Care Manager visits
- › Receive Care Manager assistance if relocation is needed
- › Have companionship in a warm and caring home

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
