



Senior Training and Employment Program (STEP) provides training and job readiness assistance to help those who have limited employment prospects get jobs in the private or public sector.

Qualified individuals must be:

- Age 55 years or older
- A resident of Allegheny County
- Currently unemployed
- Residing in a household with a total family income that does not exceed 125% of the current federal poverty level

Services include:

- Community-service, work-based training in a variety of government or non-profit agencies
- Resume preparation assistance
- Interviewing skills training
- Job searching utilizing CareerLink.
