What is a Key Communicator?

A Key Communicator is someone who receives information from Allegheny County (AC) OID and, when possible, forwards it to others who may also benefit from it.

Who are Key Communicators?

Key Communicators include:

- ◆ Persons registered with OID and family members, friends and caregivers
- ◆ Community and faith based organization members
- ◆ Human service professionals including Direct Support Professionals
- ◆ Supports Coordinators and other 'case managers'
- ◆ Special Education students, families and professionals

What kinds of information may I receive?

- ◆ Caregiver support and education opportunities
- ◆ Community and specially designed programs and events
- ◆ Community and human service system resources
- ◆ Information from the PA Office of Developmental Programs (ODP)
- ◆ New and updated FactSheets as developed by OID
- ◆ Resources and programs from AC DHS and DHS Offices
- ◆ Special education information
- ◆ Workshops, meetings and conferences

How will I know the email is from OID and if it will be of interest to me?

The subject line of the email will say *A Message from AC OID* and will include the general nature of the information being shared.

How often will I receive emails?

Usually several times a month.

Who could I share the emails with?

- ◆ Persons registered with OID and families, friends and caregivers
- ◆ Family/Support Groups
- ◆ Community and faith based organizations
- ◆ Human services professionals including Direct Support Professionals
- ◆ Supports Coordinators and other 'case managers'
- ◆ Special Education students, families and professionals
