Allegheny County, City of Pittsburgh and Pittsburgh Steelers to Host Playoff Rally

PITTSBURGH – Allegheny County, City of Pittsburgh and the Pittsburgh Steelers today announced a playoff rally will be held at Noon on Friday, January 2, 2015 in the Courthouse Courtyard. Fans are encouraged to show off their Steelers pride, and help decorate the “Terrible Tree,” as the team prepares to make its postseason appearance against the Baltimore Ravens.

In addition to rooting on the Steelers, there will be music beginning at 11:30 a.m. and Steelers prizes during the rally. There will also be an appearance by Steely McBeam and Steelers alumni, and a performance by the Steelers Drumline (SteeLine).

From 11:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m., the NBC Sports *Sunday Night Football* Bus will also be parked on Forbes Avenue outside of the Courthouse for fans to visit. A replica Vince Lombardi Trophy is also available for fan photos.
