Fitzgerald Submits Bills for October 5 Meeting; To Present 2017 Proposed Budget

PITTSBURGH – County Executive Rich Fitzgerald submitted two bills to County Council for consideration at its upcoming October 5th meeting:

- Ordinance authorizing the transfer of custody of certain county photographs to the Historical Society of Western Pennsylvania to allow for their maintenance and preservation at no cost to the county; the photographs will be maintained under preservation guidelines established by the Society of American Archivists and for public access to these records at the Senator John Heinz History Center
- Ordinance permitting Cranetown Media LLC to film in and around the Allegheny County Courthouse and Family Court Building, and to use certain county-owned property as props if needed, in connection with a Netflix television drama entitled “Mindhunter” with filming tentatively scheduled for October 29 and 30

Additionally, the County Executive will appear at the Wednesday, October 5, 2016 meeting of Council to present his 2017 Comprehensive Fiscal Plan.
