

## PUBLIC NOTICE OF HEARING MAY 12TH, 4PM

Allegheny County Council will hold a public hearing pursuant to the Tax Increment Financing Act of 1990, to afford interested parties an opportunity to express their views on three bills proposed by the Chief Executive to amend an existing Tax Increment Finance District and to create two additional Tax Increment Finance Districts which are as follows: Bill No. 8889-15, proposed amendment to the Tax Increment Financing Plan, Clinton Industrial Park Phase 1; Bill No. 8890-15, proposed Clinton Commerce Park Phase II Tax Increment Financing District; and Bill No. 8891-15, proposed McClaren Road Tax Increment Financing District, all located in the Township of Findlay, Allegheny County. The hearing will commence Tuesday, May 12, 2015 at 4PM in the Gold Room, 4<sup>th</sup> Floor County Courthouse, 436 Grant Street, Pittsburgh, PA to address each bill in sequence as they appear in this notice.

The hearing will allow opportunity for comments by the general public to express their views on the concept of tax increment financing, on the proposed creation of a tax increment district and its proposed boundaries, on the proposed adoption of a project plan for the district and the benefits to the municipality. Individuals wishing to speak must register in advance at least 24 hours before the scheduled beginning of the hearing, and in accordance with all applicable rules governing public comment at Council meetings which can be found on the County Council webpage at the following link: <http://www.alleghenycounty.us/council/meetings/comment.aspx>.
