## *Proclamation*

**WHEREAS**, Mr. Theodore M. Trbovich is retiring from the Allegheny County Law Department after 32 years of service; and

**WHEREAS**, Mr. Trbovich, originally from the Greenfield neighborhood of Pittsburgh, grew up in "The Run;" he received his B.A. in Education from Duquesne University in 1969, and his J.D. from the same university in 1972; and

**WHEREAS**, after graduating from law school, Mr. Trbovich was on active duty in the U.S. Army from August to October of 1972 and was honorably discharged with the rank of Captain; as a practicing attorney for almost 42 years, he has maintained a private practice in the South Hills, and most recently in Greenfield; and

**WHEREAS**, Mr. Trbovich joined the Allegheny County Law Department in December 1981 and was assigned to serve as the assistant solicitor to the County Department of Aviation from 1982-1999; in that role he was actively involved in addressing and handling a wide variety of legal issues on behalf of the County during the course of construction of the Mid-Field Terminal Project, which was one of the largest construction projects ever undertaken in Western Pennsylvania; more recently, Mr. Trbovich has provided legal advice to the Departments of Human Services, Economic Development, Public Works, and MWDDBE; and

**WHEREAS**, Mr. Trbovich has played an essential role in Allegheny County and we are thankful for his dedication and work throughout the years; his experience and role within the Law Department will be difficult to replace.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that I, Allegheny County Executive Rich Fitzgerald, by virtue of the authority vested in me, do hereby congratulate Mr. Theodore M. Trbovich and wish him a well-deserved, happy, and health retirement!
