Proclamation

WHEREAS, Neighborhood Legal Service Association (NLSA), along with Art Rooney, II, is celebrating six native western Pennsylvania quarterbacks who are members of the Pro Football Hall of Fame at “Gridiron Gold” on June 6, 2015; and

WHEREAS, this special recognition event will honor George Blanda, Jim Kelly, Dan Marino, Joe Montana, Joe Namath, and Johnny Unitas; four of these talented men will take part in a discussion where they will have an opportunity to reflect on their careers and how the region helped shape them as men and players; and

WHEREAS, Joe Montana, selected by the San Francisco 49ers in the third round of the 1979 NFL Draft, had a stellar career with the 49ers and Kansas City Chiefs; he was a master of late-game comebacks and directed his teams to 31 fourth quarter come-from-behind wins during his illustrious career, including a 92-yard drive in the closing seconds of Super Bowl XXIII; Mr. Montana was named All-NFL three times and All-NFC on five occasions; he was voted to the Pro Bowl eight times, which was a league record for a quarterback at the time; and

WHEREAS, western Pennsylvania has a distinct love of sports and is loyal to those from its community; we are extremely proud of Joe Montana, and all that he accomplished throughout his career; he has set an excellent example to many youth in our region and has been a role model of which we can be proud; and

WHEREAS, the involvement of Jim Kelly, Dan Marino, Joe Montana, Joe Namath, and the families of Johnny Unitas and George Blanda is extremely generous and displays their kindness toward our community; the NLSA, which will receive the proceeds from the event, has been working for 50 years to restore hope to vulnerable individuals and families in our region – hope that comes in the form of equal access to justice.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that I, Allegheny County Executive Rich Fitzgerald, by virtue of the authority vested in me, do hereby congratulate all six quarterbacks on their successful careers; we are proud that they hail from western Pennsylvania and for the commitment they still have to our region.
