August 5	Notification letters mailed announcing 2017 (Year 43) CDBG Program to local units of Government, Council of Governments (COGs), Authorities, Operating Agencies, and Non-Profit/For-Profit Organizations.

September 16	<u>ACED Deadline</u> for all public improvement <u>pre-applications</u> from local units of Government, COGs, Authorities, Operating Agencies, and Non-Profit/For-Profit Organizations. (Check with your local COG Office for the pre-application deadline for submission to that Office.)
November 18	<u>ACED Deadline</u> for all <u>applications</u> from local units of Government, COGs, Authorities, Operating Agencies, and Non-Profit/For-Profit Organizations. (Check with your local COG Office for the application deadline for submission to that Office.)
November 21, 2016 - January 20, 2017	ACED and other County Agencies review applications for compliance with National Objectives and Consolidated Plan Priorities.

January 23 – February 3	Selection of eligible projects for proposed 2017 (Year 43) CDBG funding by ACED Divisions.
February 6 – March 3	Budget meetings with the ACED Director to review selected projects.
March 15	Draft Annual Action Plan Public Hearing.
April 5 – May 5	Draft Annual Action Plan on display for 30-day public review and comment period.
1st Week of May	Annual Action Plan Public Hearing – Date to be announced*.
May 15	Final Annual Action Plan submitted to HUD (45 days before Program Year starts).
July 1	2017 (Year 43) CDBG Program Year effective date.
