EMERGENCY DEMOLTION

An emergency is defined as a situation where a structure is an imminent danger to life, health, or safety as the result of a catastrophic event such as fire, lightening strike, partial building collapse, landslide, etc... that occurred within 14 days prior to the request for funding.

In this instance ACED will waive normal procurement and lead safe requirements. Applicants will be permitted to solicit bids for the demolition from 3 contractors.

The municipality still must obtain legal clearance prior to demolition.

Other guidelines may be waived as applicable
