CONTINUUM OF CARE SPECIFIC CLINICS

THERE ARE TWO CLINICS THAT SPECIFICALLY SERVE THOSE EXPERIENCING HOMELESSNESS WITHIN THE CONTINUUM OF CARE (COC). THERE IS THE PATH CLINIC THROUGH COMMUNITY HUMAN SERVICES THAT FOCUSES ON MENTAL HEALTH NEEDS AND THEN ALSO THE CLINIC AT SECOND AVENUE COMMONS THROUGH UPMC THAT CAN ASSIST WITH A BROADER VARIETY OF NEEDS.

COMMUNITY HUMAN SERVICES PATH CLINIC

Eligibility: Those experiencing homelessness who have a concern around or a diagnosed mental illness

Referral Process: Support person will complete a PATH Referral Form for the client and email it to referral365@chscorp.org

Expectation after Referral: Once a referral is sent in, the CHS intake team will complete the PATH intake. The team will then work with one of the clinicians to schedule an initial appointment for the participant. Depending on the number of referrals the turnaround time is usually 1-2 weeks to screen and then another 1-2 weeks before an appointment.

Services Provided: Outpatient Therapeutic sessions with a Licensed Social Worker and limited prescribing with a CRNP if engaged with a treatment plan.

- Treatment of acute medical conditions related to skin, urinary, respiratory infections, etc.

- Treatment of chronic medical conditions like diabetes, high blood pressure, and COPD.
- Wound care, minor injuries, and suturing.
