I. CALL TO ORDER: Meeting was called to order by Mr. DeFazio at 3:00 p.m.

II. PUBLIC COMMENT: Jim Roddey raised concerns about entering into another lawsuit since the ACLU already has a lawsuit pending in the Commonwealth Court. A lawsuit should be brought by the Democratic Party, not Allegheny County.

Beverly Weiss, Esq., is in agreement with Jim Roddey about spending County resources on a lawsuit. She suggested that we double the amount of provisional ballots that are normally sent to the polling places. She also suggested that the ACLU & League of Women Voters educate the voters.

III. CONSIDERATION OF LAWSUIT CHALLENGING ACT 18 OF 2012:

Ms. Heidelbaugh disagrees with filing an additional lawsuit at the taxpayers expense since the ACLU has one pending in Commonwealth Court. Commonwealth Court will make the decision.
