



The mission of the Latino Community Center is to empower, advocate with, and celebrate Latinos in Allegheny County. We envision a Pittsburgh community in which all Latinos are valued and have equal and equitable access to the resources needed to thrive.

Our Story

In 2015, a comprehensive Latino Needs Assessment was conducted to determine the greatest needs for the Latino Community in Allegheny County. After completion of that assessment, the Allegheny Intermediate Unit (AIU) completed a strategic plan for the Latino Family Center to identify a service-delivery plan to address these needs. This process revealed a critical need for an adaptation of the Latino Family Center that would be a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization with a majority Latino board of directors. In 2017, the **Latino Community Center** was established to fill this need and provide family and educational support services to Latinos in Pittsburgh. In July 2020, this transition process will be complete, and the Latino Community Center will become the fiscal agent of the Latino Family Center.
