

JRS Eligibility Considerations

You ***are not*** eligible for JRS if your current charge(s) or criminal record includes any of the following crimes or detainers:

- Criminal homicide
- Criminal attempted homicide
- Out-of-county detainers
- Out-of-state detainers
- Federal detainers
- Shuman Detention Center detainers
- Family Division detainers
 - PFA violations
 - Child support
- Only summary charges
- Only traffic charges

Mental Health Court - Additional Eligibility Considerations

You ***are not*** eligible for Mental Health Court if your current charge(s) includes any of the following crimes. Nor are you eligible for Mental Court if you have only a probation violation.

- Assault by prisoner
- Drug trafficking
- DUI
- Homicide offenses
- Sexual offenses
- Theft by extortion with threats of violence

You ***may be*** eligible for Mental Health Court with a charge listed below but your case will need to be reviewed.

- Aggravated assault
- Arson
- Burglary
- Robbery
- Violations of the Uniform Firearms Act (VUFA)
