



Choose your caregiver carefully...*your baby is counting on you.*

Very few people believe that someone they love or trust could ever hurt their child. *But it happens.*

Before leaving your child in someone's care, ask about the caregiver's experience and how that person would respond to an upset or unwell child. Post an emergency contact list in a visible place, on your refrigerator, for example.

Choose your caregiver and caregiving partner carefully. Your child's life may depend on it. Never leave your child with someone you don't trust to keep your child safe. Many children are harmed each year by adults who are not trustworthy or who just don't know how to take care of a child. Your baby is counting on you to make the right decision.
