A Dangerous Relationship Assessment App
from Women's Center & Shelter of Greater Pittsburgh

RUSafe is a free dangerous relationship assessment app for Apple or Android that invites the user to answer a series of questions about her/his relationship. The app then calculates the responses and, if there is cause for concern, it will enable the user to directly call our 24-Hour Hotline. If the user is in immediate, lethal danger, she/he can call 911 directly from the app. RUSafe is based on the Danger Assessment developed by Jacquelyn C. Campbell, PhD, RN, FAAN of Johns Hopkins School of Nursing. The app was developed by WC&S and Newton Consulting, who generously donated their time and services to help bring it to life.
