Fitzgerald Statement on Passage of 2015 Operating and Capital Budgets

PITTSBURGH – Allegheny County Executive Rich Fitzgerald issued the following statement this evening following the passage of the 2015 Operating and Capital Budgets by Allegheny County Council:

“I thank the members of Allegheny County Council for their continued partnership in doing the right things for the County’s fiscal health in setting the 2015 Operating and Capital Budgets. I’m proud that these budgets require no tax increase, do not rely on any one-time revenues, and hold our growth and increases to a reasonable level.
