Allegheny County Human Services Offers Casework Career Sessions

PITTSBURGH – Allegheny County Department of Human Services (DHS) Office of Children, Youth and Families (CYF) is stepping up efforts to encourage people to consider casework as a career.

CYF is currently looking for people interested in working in support of children and families in Allegheny County. Representatives will be present at several upcoming information sessions, with more dates to be scheduled throughout the fall and winter. Since all CYF caseworkers are required to have completed their PA State Civil Service Commission testing and application, these sessions are also an opportunity to learn about navigating the civil service process.
