Arrest Made of Suspect in Two Bank Robberies

PITTSBURGH – This afternoon, Allegheny County Police made an arrest of a suspect in two bank robberies as he was attempting to leave the state. Robert Charles Stiver, 68-years-old, was arrested at 2:30 p.m. in the terminal of Pittsburgh International Airport while waiting on a flight to Pompano Beach, Florida.

Stiver was identified as a suspect in a robbery of the First Commonwealth Bank in Harmar Township on Friday. He was also a suspect in a robbery of an Allegheny Valley Bank in November in Shaler Township. He will be transported to the Allegheny County Jail for arraignment on charges related to both robberies.

Police from Harmar Township, Shaler Township, Allegheny County and the Federal Bureau of Investigation were all involved in the investigation and arrest of Stiver..
