County Police Make Arrest in Stabbing in Homestead Borough

Homestead Borough, Allegheny County – At approximately 9:55 a.m. today, the Homestead Police and first responders were dispatched to 207 East Tenth Avenue in response to a 9-1-1 call about a man being stabbed there. When they arrived, they found a 55-year-old man suffering from a stab wound to the chest. The victim was transported to a local hospital where he is listed in critical condition.

Through the course of the investigation it was determined that Bertha Morris, 56, stabbed the victim during an argument. Morris will be charged with aggravated assault and tampering with evidence. She will be lodged at the Allegheny County Jail to await arraignment on those charges.
