Fitzgerald Submits Three Bills for Consideration at October 24 Council Meeting

PITTSBURGH – County Executive Rich Fitzgerald submitted three bills to County Council for referral or consideration at its upcoming October 24, 2017 meeting:

- Ordinance making revisions to Article XI, Hearings and Appeals, of the Health Department's Rules and Regulations to add definitions, extend appeals periods, accepting electronically-filed appeals, establishing a process for dealing with discovery, and additional procedural changes. These changes were approved by the Board of Health at its July 2017 meeting.
- Ordinance making revisions to Article XXI, Air Pollution Control, of the Health Department's Rules and Regulations to bring the county into compliance with recently revised regulations at the state level which lower the allowable sulfur content of commercial fuel oil. The Board of Health approved these changes at its May 2017 meeting.
- Ordinance amending Ordinance No. 01-16-OR to extend the expiration date of the blanket ordinance which authorizes the Law and Public Works Departments to administer routine permits, conveyances and acquisitions of real property.
