Fitzgerald Submits Two Bills for Consideration at December 5 Council Meeting

PITTSBURGH – County Executive Rich Fitzgerald submitted two bills to County Council for referral or consideration at its upcoming December 5, 2017 meeting:

- Ordinance authorizing the sale of the former Health Department Forbes Medical Building located at 3441 Forbes Avenue in the City of Pittsburgh, 4th ward, for the sale price of \$1,900,000 to 3441 F Street, LLC. The University of Pittsburgh submitted the only proposal in response to a Request for Development Proposal and has created the LLC for the purpose of purchasing and developing the property.
- Resolution approving a project for the benefit of Presbyterian Senior Care to be financed by the Authority for Improvements in Municipalities by the issuance of up to \$12,500,000 in tax exempt bonds. The proceeds will be used to finance the costs of constructing, equipping and furnishing a 36-bed assisted living facility for Alzheimer's and dementia patients, to be located in South Strabane Township, Washington County, and to pay all or a portion of the related financing costs.
