Allegheny County SummerFood Program Begins This Month

PITTSBURGH – Starting June 12 through August 18, 2017, the Department of Human Services will operate the SummerFood program, a free breakfast, lunch and recreation program for children through 18 years old, as well as eligible individuals with disabilities.

Nutritious meals will be available on weekdays at more than 80 sites throughout the county. A site supervisor and accompanying staff will be present to ensure the well-being of the children.
