



PITTSBURGH CRIME STOPPERS

December 6, 2017 – Pittsburgh Crime Stoppers is asking for the public’s help with an unsolved homicide case in Penn Hills, PA.

On October 19, 2017, a 39-year-old male victim identified as Jerry Alston was found deceased at his Penn Hills residence with two apparent gunshot wounds to his head. Based on the evidence uncovered by police, foul play is suspected and the manner of death was ruled criminal homicide.

The police investigation has developed a person of interest in this case and detectives would like to identify and speak to this individual. The person can be seen on surveillance video inside of a local McDonald’s restaurant and is described as an older black male with a white beard, operating a light-colored SUV.
