Arrest Warrant Issued in Duquesne Shooting

Allegheny County – On Friday evening, September 28, 2018, at approximately 10:10 p.m., the Duquesne Police and medics were dispatched to an address on South Fifth Street in response to a 9-1-1 call about a shooting. There they found a 29-year-old male suffering from multiple gunshot wounds. He was transported to a local hospital in critical but stable condition.

Detectives from the Allegheny County Police Homicide Unit responded to the scene. Through the course of the investigation, it was determined that 26-year-old Elijah Lewis-White was the person responsible for the shooting.

An arrest warrant has been issued for Elijah Lewis-White charging him with attempted homicide and aggravated assault. He is described as 5'6" tall with a medium build. Anyone sighting Lewis-White should call 9-1-1 immediately. Anyone with information concerning his whereabouts is asked to call the Allegheny County Police Tip Line at **1-833-ALL-TIPS**; callers can remain anonymous.
