Woman Hit by Train in Harrison Township

Harrison, Allegheny County – At approximately 7:25 p.m. on Wednesday, October 3, 2018, the Harrison Township Police and paramedics were dispatched to the intersection of Mile Lock Lane and Sixth Avenue in response to 9-1-1 calls about a person struck by a train. There they found a 40-year-old female suffering from massive trauma; she was pronounced dead at the scene.

Detectives from the Allegheny County Police Homicide Unit responded to the scene. Through interviews with witnesses, it was determined that the female had been walking along the tracks when the train approached from behind her. The train activated all of its warning devices in an effort to get her attention. The woman did not move in time and was struck. No foul play is suspected at this time.
