



## **PITTSBURGH CRIME STOPPERS**

Pittsburgh Crime Stoppers is seeking the public's assistance with an open homicide investigation.

On June 22, 2018 at around 2:14 a.m., a Homestead Police officer heard numerous gunshots coming from the Munhall area. While responding to the area, police officers from Munhall and Homestead were dispatched by Allegheny County 9-1-1 to the area of 1324 Margaret Street in Munhall for a report of multiple gunshots.

As one of the officers was approaching the area, he was stopped by a female who reported that she had fled from a vehicle in the area of the 1300 block of Margaret Street. It was discovered that the female had suffered a gunshot wound. Upon other officers' arrival to the 1300 block of Margaret Street, they discovered a silver colored Nissan with several doors open and numerous bullet holes in the vehicle. A female, identified as 19-year-old Jazmere Custis, was seated in the driver's seat and had suffered numerous gunshot wounds. She was declared deceased at the scene. Police also discovered two males nearby who had been in the silver Nissan and were suffering from gunshot wounds. The Allegheny County Police Homicide Unit was contacted and began an investigation.

It was learned that the four victims that were in the silver Nissan had been at a party in Homestead and had just pulled up to the area of 1324 Margaret Street when the shooting occurred. While the Nissan was parked on the street, unknown persons approached in another vehicle and shot into the silver Nissan striking all four victims.
