



## PITTSBURGH CRIME STOPPERS

WILMERDING, PA– The Allegheny County Police Department is asking for the public’s help with identifying access device fraud suspects.

Over the past several months, multiple victims in the Wilmerding area have reported that their credit/debit card information was fraudulently used at various retail locations in Allegheny County. Police are in the process of determining how the victims’ credit card information was obtained.

Investigation has revealed three suspects who were caught on store surveillance cameras making the fraudulent purchases.
