## **County Police Assisting with Second Jones Avenue Shooting in N Braddock**

**North Braddock Borough, Allegheny County** – On November 20, at about 8:10 p.m., County 9-1-1 was notified of a shooting in the 600 block of Jones Avenue. North Braddock Police found an 85-year-old male inside a business suffering from gunshot wounds. The victim was transported to a local trauma hospital where he is listed in critical condition.

On November 19, at approximately 2:04 p.m., the North Braddock Police and paramedics were dispatched to the 600 block of Jones Avenue in response to 9-1-1 calls about a person who was shot. There they found a 46-year-old male suffering from a gunshot wound to his leg. He was transported to a local hospital where he is in stable condition with a non-life-threatening wound.

Allegheny County Police Homicide Detectives initiated an investigation. The investigation has revealed that today's shooting is related to yesterday's; however, the motive for the shootings is unclear. County Police are planning to make an arrest for both shootings. More details will be released as they become available.
