



PITTSBURGH CRIME STOPPERS

NORTH BRADDOCK BOROUGH, ALLEGHENY COUNTY – The Allegheny County Police Department is asking for the public’s help with an unsolved homicide case.

On November 19, 2018, at approximately 2:04 P.M., North Braddock Police responded to Jones Avenue in response to a call for a 44-year-old male who sustained a gunshot wound to his leg. The victim survived his injury and reported that he was robbed at gunpoint by a male actor inside of the Cool Breeze mobile electronics store. The actor shot the victim in the leg when he tried to struggle with the actor.

The following day, on November 20, 2018 around 8:15 p.m., North Braddock Police were called again to Jones Avenue for another shooting incident. An 85-year-old male victim had sustained a gunshot wound to his lower back. The victim survived his injury and told police he was inside of Cool Breeze mobile electronics store when a male actor came in with a gun and began shooting at him.

County Police Detectives identified 20-year old Courde Daye as a suspect in both of these shooting incidents. There are arrest warrants for Daye and police are actively searching for his whereabouts. **Daye should be considered armed and extremely dangerous.** Anyone seeing him, or having information regarding his whereabouts, is asked to call 9-1-1.
