County Police Investigating Reported O'Hara Township Child Abduction

Allegheny County – On December 28, 2018 at approximately 10:20 a.m., the O'Hara Township Police responded to a reported child abduction at 8 Mary Street. Officers were told that a one-month-old child had been abducted by 29-year-old Ashton Curtis. Curtis was said to be operating a silver SUV bearing Texas license plates.

Following a BOLO for the vehicle and driver, the SUV was stopped at approximately 11:55 a.m. on Interstate 70 in Washington County by Pennsylvania State Police Troopers. Curtis was taken into custody without incident, and the child was safely recovered.

At the request of the O'Hara Township Police, detectives from the Allegheny County Police Department (ACPD) assumed the investigation. ACPD detectives are currently conducting interviews with the involved parties; once appropriate criminal charges are determined and filed, additional updates will follow.
