Nadine Road in Penn Hills Reopens to Traffic

PITTSBURGH – The Department of Public Works announced today that Nadine Road between Allegheny River Boulevard and Lincoln Road in Penn Hills has reopened to traffic.

The closure began on July 12, 2019 following storms that caused a retaining wall to fall over and a portion of the road to collapse. Between August 20 and today, crews removed the damaged wall, excavated, constructed a new retaining wall, relocated utilities, and made roadway and drainage repairs.

The work was done by Northeast Paving, a division of Eurovia Atlantic Coast, LLC, of Pittsburgh, as part of the \$10.7 million 2019 Capital Roads Reconstruction contract.
