Fitzgerald Submits Five Bills to Council for its September 8 Meeting

PITTSBURGH – County Executive Rich Fitzgerald submitted five bills to Council for its referral or consideration at its upcoming September 8 meeting:

- Ordinance authorizing the continued use of a structure on Brownsville Road in South Park near the fairgrounds by the Mon Valley Express Drum & Bugle Corps for the purpose of conducting marching band and music-related activities; the authorization begins on October 1 and continues through September 30, 2023.
- Ordinance authorizing the continued use of a structure on Brownsville Road in South Park by Allegheny County Budo-Kai for the purpose of conducting martial arts instruction and related activities; the authorization begins on October 1 and continues through September 30, 2023.
- Ordinance authorizing the sale of property on McWhinney Street in Munhall Borough to Gregory Baranowski for \$1,500; the proceeds of the sale will be shared equally by the county, borough and school district.
- Ordinance amending the Administrative Code, Article 808.B entitled “Rental Vehicle Taxation” to address modes of transportation not contemplated under the original ordinance; specifically, the amendment would exclude motorcycles, motor-driven cycles and motor-drive scooters.
- Resolution authorizing the adoption of rules and regulations for the Human Relations Commission.
