County Police Narcotics Investigation Leads to Seizure and Arrest

Allegheny County – As a result of an ongoing investigation, detectives of the Allegheny County Police Narcotics, Vice, and Intelligence Unit obtained a search warrant on Tuesday, August 25, 2020. The search warrant identified an apartment in the 2100 block of Rhine Street in Pittsburgh's Spring Hill neighborhood, occupied by 33-year-old Vaughn Malone. Malone was suspected of selling cocaine out of the residence and is currently on PA State Parole. That search warrant was served today with the assistance of the Pittsburgh Bureau of Police.

Approximately 64 grams of cocaine, 11 ½ grams of crystal methamphetamine, \$13,926.00 cash, and two pistols were seized as a result of the search. One of the pistols had been reported stolen. Malone was arrested and charged with receiving stolen property as well as several narcotics and firearms related offenses.
