County Police File Homicide Charges in McKees Rocks Woman's Death

Allegheny County – On May 4, 2020 at 9:46 a.m., the McKees Rocks Police were called to 96 Helen Street for a body found in a refrigerator. When officers arrived, they observed a unplugged refrigerator in a common area of the apartment building and confirmed the existence of a decomposed body inside. The body was identified as Kristy Jefferson who was reported missing on April 29, 2020. Detectives charged 41-year-old Daryl Jones with abuse of corpse.

On June 26, 2020, the Allegheny County Medical Examiner's Office ruled Jefferson's manner of death a homicide and cause of death undetermined. On September 3, 2020, County Police charged Daryl Jones with criminal homicide. Jones is being held at the Allegheny County Jail awaiting arraignment.
