## **Firearm Found at Main Checkpoint, Pittsburgh International Airport**

**Findlay Township, Allegheny County** – On September 4<sup>th</sup> at 9:38 AM, Transportation Security Administration (TSA) screeners observed a loaded .380 caliber handgun within a passenger's carry-on bag at the main security checkpoint of Pittsburgh International Airport. The Allegheny County Police were alerted of the finding.

County Police were able to determine that the 53-year-old male passenger possessed a valid concealed carry permit and inadvertently left the firearm in his bag. The Federal Bureau of Investigation was notified, and the passenger was permitted to fly. At this time, charges are not expected to be filed by County Police.

The firearm is in the custody of County Police.
