REMINDER: Part of Prospect Road in Baldwin Borough to Close Monday

PITTSBURGH – The Department of Public Works announced that Prospect Road will close between Beryl Drive and the entrance to the Carapel Townhouses in Baldwin Borough starting at 9 a.m. on Monday, September 14, 2020. The closure is expected to end in October 2020 and will be followed by periodic single-lane closures until November 2020.

The restrictions are required for slope stabilization work. That includes installation of a rock embankment, concrete barrier, erosion and sedimentation control, and pavement markings as well as excavation, drainage repairs, clearing and grubbing, and milling and paving.

During the closure, traffic will be [detoured](#) using East Willock Road and Streets Run Road. During the periodic single-lane closures, traffic will be controlled using flaggers. Nearby residents will have access to their homes at all times.

The northbound lane of that section of Prospect Road has been closed at the landslide site since February 14, 2019. Traffic is currently being controlled using alternating traffic signals.

The \$325,950 project is being done by Michael Facchiano Contracting, Inc., of Mt. Lebanon.
