## **Nadine Road Reopens to Traffic; Short Stoppages in Work Zones Continue**

**PITTSBURGH** – The Department of Public Works announced today that Nadine Road between Lincoln Road and Allegheny River Boulevard (Route 130) in Penn Hills has reopened to traffic. The closure, which began on August 10, 2020, was required for construction of two support walls and installation of a drainage pipe.

As previously announced, paving and other miscellaneous construction will continue on Nadine Road until October 2020. While that work is taking place, drivers can expect to experience short stoppages in work zones. Flaggers are being used to control traffic, and drivers are urged to use caution in the area.

The overall project, which began on February 28, 2020, also has included removal of a pipe restricting water flow from a box culvert, roadway repairs, and signage installation.

The work is being done by Northeast Paving, a division of Eurovia Atlantic Coast, LLC, of Pittsburgh, as part of the \$10.7 million 2019 Capital Roads contract.
