Prospect Road in Baldwin Borough Reopens to Traffic

PITTSBURGH – The Department of Public Works announced today that Prospect Road between Beryl Drive and the entrance to the Carapel Townhouses in Baldwin Borough has reopened to traffic earlier than expected. A full closure of the road, which began on September 14, 2020, was needed for slope stabilization work. That included excavation, clearing and grubbing, drainage repairs, milling and paving, as well as installation of a rock embankment, concrete barrier, and erosion and sedimentation control.

The northbound lane of that section of Prospect Road had been closed since February 14, 2019, following a landslide.

The \$325,950 project was done by Michael Facchiano Contracting, Inc., of Mt. Lebanon.
