

Allegheny County Monthly Hotel Tax Distribution

The current Hotel Tax is 7%

The 7% Tax is broken by statute into two parts; the original 5% Tax and a 2% increase.

- ❖ 2% Tax or 40 % of the total monthly collections
- ❖ 5% Tax or 60 % of total monthly collections

❖ Two Percent Tax Breakdown

- a. 33% of 2% of the tax received from Monroeville hotels is mandated for the Municipality of Monroeville (to be used to fund the Expo Mart)
- b. Remaining balance is used as a portion of Debt Service payment (debt incurred to fund David Lawrence Convention Center and Stadiums)

❖ Five Percent Tax Breakdown

- a. 33% of 5% of the tax received from Monroeville hotels is mandated for the Municipality of Monroeville (to be used to fund the Expo Mart)
- b. This portion of the Debt Service payment (calculated by subtracting 2% section (b) from the debt scheduled payment due)
- c. Allegheny County General Fund receives 5% of the 5% tax
- d. 40% of the 5% tax collected is allocated to Visit Pittsburgh (Tourism Promotions)
- e. Remaining balance, if any is to be allocated to the Sports and Exhibition Authority for operational use
