Proclamation

WHEREAS, nearly 18 months ago, Allegheny County Emergency Services (ACES) began the process of building a Records Management System (RMS) with the CAD used at the 9-1-1 Center; and

WHEREAS, with permission from the Franklin Park Borough Council, Police Sergeant Walter Healy was named by the Allegheny County Chiefs of Police Association to act as a liaison between ACES and the many law enforcement agencies involved in this process; and

WHEREAS, after many months and much cooperative work, Allegheny County's first RMS went live on April 28, 2015; to date, 22 police departments have received training, five of which went live with the new RMS system; and

WHEREAS, this system is a welcomed relief for police departments within Allegheny County; for some distressed communities, this system is the first RMS available at no cost; law enforcement agencies across the county are now able to sync data between their agencies and provide a greater service to the public; and

WHEREAS, Sergeant Walter Healy's expertise in the field of law enforcement proved to add the necessary information needed to make this RMS project a success; Allegheny County is thankful for Franklin Park Borough Council and its generosity in allowing Sergeant Healy to assist with this important project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that I, Allegheny County Executive Rich Fitzgerald, by virtue of the authority vested in me, do hereby thank the Franklin Park Borough Council for its commitment in working with ACES to create a successful RMS system for the residents of our county.
