WHEREAS, Judge Livingstone M. Johnson, born on Tuesday, December 27, 1927, will celebrate his 90th birthday this year; deeply appreciated and loved by his friends and family, they are joining together to wish him a happy birthday and many more years ahead; and

WHEREAS, Judge Johnson, an O'Hara Township resident for 57 years, was born in Wilksburg, Pennsylvania to former Allegheny County District Attorney Oliver Livingstone Johnson and Irene Johnson; he is an Eagle Scout, and attended Howard University and University of Michigan Law School; and

WHEREAS, Judge Johnson married his wife, Lee Brun, 57 years ago, and together they are blessed with five children: Lee Carol, Oliver, Judy, Livingstone, and Patty; they also are fortunate to have nine grandchildren: Lauren, Kristen, Robinson, Ellison, Emma, Jacob, Olivia, Lillian, and Alexander; and

WHEREAS, Judge Johnson served in the Air Force during the Korean War as a Navigator Radar Bombardier and flew 58 combat missions; he was awarded the Distinguished Flying Cross, Commendation Medal, Air Medal, and three Oak Leaf Clusters; he is a charter member of the Allegheny County Hall of Valor in Soldiers and Sailors Memorial Hall and Museum; we are extremely grateful to Judge Johnson for his sacrifice and service; and

WHEREAS, Judge Johnson practiced law at a family firm until 1962, when he began serving as an Assistant Solicitor in the county; he became a judge on the Allegheny County Court of Common Pleas in 1973 and remained in that position until 1997, when he took senior status; he retired after a distinguished career in 2007; and
