WHEREAS, the Sewickley Academy girls tennis team defeated Wyomissing High School, 3-2, in the PLAA Class 2A finals on October 27, 2018 at Hershey Racquet Club; and

WHEREAS, the victory gave Sewickley Academy its first girls tennis state team championship since 2011 and made the Panthers the only Class 2A program in WPLAL history with two PLAA titles; and

WHEREAS, Sewickley Academy claimed the crown by sweeping its singles matches, which were all won by sophomores; Evelyn Safar triumphed, 6-1, 6-0, at first singles, Christina Walton won, 6-3, 6-0 at third singles, and Simran Bedi sealed the title with a 6-3, 6-0 victory; and

WHEREAS, Sewickley Academy's championship season would not have been possible without the exceptional leadership of coach Whitney Snyder, who developed a lineup of nearly all underclassmen into a powerhouse team that repeatedly came through in the clutch; and

WHEREAS, we thank the players, coaches, students, administrators, parents, and all others involved with the team for representing this region so well and for making Allegheny County proud at the PLAA championships and throughout this incredibly exciting tennis season.
