The performers are kindergarten through 12th grade students in my district, and each of them adds their own special element to my show. But a couple years ago, some of the parents came up to me after one of our shows and told me that their children had been scouring the house the entire day prior to the show, turning over couch cushions, raiding desk doors trying to find coins.
