

**REQUEST TO COMMENT
AT A MEETING OF
ALLEGHENY COUNTY COUNCIL**

Act 20 of the General Assembly of Pennsylvania (enacted June 15, 1993 and amended by Act 93 on October 15, 1998) provides for reasonable opportunity for residents of or taxpayers to Allegheny County (and other political subdivisions) to comment on governmental matters, official actions, or deliberations which are or may be before the Allegheny County Council prior to the taking of official action. The term "official action" is defined in the Sunshine Law to include "a vote...on any proposal, resolution, rule, regulation, ordinance, report or order."
