# MON VALLEY PUBLIC FUND APPLICATION INFORMATION

Allegheny County Economic Development (ACED) is pleased to announce that the application portal for the first round of funding for the Mon Valley Public Health Fund is scheduled to go live on Monday, June 3, 2024.

### **Minimum Proposal Criteria**

Proposals must be exclusively designated to fund public health and welfare and/or air quality improvement projects that have a direct, tangible, positive impact on public health and welfare and/or air quality in the Mon Valley communities located near U. S. Steel's Clairton Coke Works, Edgar Thomson Plant, and Irvin Plant.

## **Applicable Restrictions**

Funds may not be used for:

- a. Advocacy or lobbying
- b. Any entity that has ever been involved in litigation against U. S. Steel may not apply.
- c. Any project that employs or utilizes the services of an entity that has testified or a non-testifying expert against U. S. Steel is not eligible.

# Who Should Apply

501(c)(3) tax-exempt entities that are located in and that serve the Mon Valley communities located near the Facilities. Those communities include Clairton, Glassport, Dravosburg, McKeesport, Port Vue, Liberty, Lincoln, West Mifflin, Braddock, North Braddock, East Pittsburgh, Duquesne, and North Versailles.
