
Age Out Loud: Community Engagement Assessment by Emily Waskowitz



My Fellowship project focuses on addressing critical gaps in community engagement within our region. The AAA's annual report estimates that there are 545,763 households in Allegheny County, with 212,455 of these being older adult households, representing a39% of the total population. According to internal data, the AAA has provided assistance to approximately 8% of the overall county population and 18% of the county's older adult population.

The data has revealed that older adults in different neighborhoods receive agency services at varying levels. Notably, Downtown, Penn Hills, and McKees Rocks show significant utilization, while service gaps are evident in neighborhoods along the northwest and southwest edges, such as Robinson, Ross, and Moon Townships. The Community Need Index currently does not highlight whether areas with low service usage also have higher percentages of marginalized populations. These insights are crucial for guiding AAA's outreach and data collection efforts in underserved areas, especially those located farther from existing resources. The longterm goal of this project is to refine community needs definitions and provide public data to incorporate more comprehensive AAA programs.
