- All topics must be relevant to meet the goals of your Foster Parent Development Plan created with you at the time of certification or recertification.

COME SHOP!

Please bring custody papers with you. If it is a brand new placement and papers have not come yet, an email from your case worker is sufficient.

Children over 6 need to be with you to shop at the donation center. Our mission is love and dignity for kids in foster care and part of that dignity is that they can pick out the clothing, styles and sizes that work best for them! We also have a sensory play room for any kids that need a break or would prefer to hang out there while parents shop.

We encourage kids to pick 7-9 outfits, 2 pairs of shoes and a pack each of socks and underwear. We allow kids to shop once a season for either spring/summer items or fall/winter. Diapers are given one time per placement.
